As the sun rose over the sacred banks of the Ganges, Yamuna, and the mystical Saraswati, Mahakumbh Prayagraj 2025 set the stage for a spectacle of spirituality and human unity. From January to March, millions gathered for this grand festival, symbolizing faith, hope, and devotion. Amidst this sea of humanity, the Indian Red Cross Society emerged as a beacon of care and compassion, playing an indispensable role in ensuring the safety and well-being of devotees.

THE PREPARATIONS: LAYING THE GROUNDWORK

Months before the festivities commenced, the Indian Red Cross Society mobilized its resources. Teams of dedicated volunteers and professionals trained in first aid, disaster management, and health services formulated a comprehensive action plan. Strategic partnerships with local authorities and health departments were forged, establishing a solid groundwork that would enable seamless integration of services during the Kumbh Mela.

History of IRCS at Kumbh Mela

The Indian Red Cross Society (IRCS) played an integral role in every Kumbh Mela since its inception. Some notable milestones included:

- In the 1934 Kumbh Mela, IRCS provided medical aid to over 10 lakh (1 million) pilgrims during the event held in Allahabad (now Prayagraj).
- During the 1966 Kumbh Mela, IRCS set up a massive medical camp with over 100 beds to cater to the needs of the pilgrims.
- In the 2013 Kumbh Mela, IRCS deployed over 20,000 volunteers and established a network of 300 health camps and hospitals.

The Indian Red Cross Society's efforts in the Mahakumbh Prayagraj 2025 stood as a testament to its commitment to serving humanity in all its forms. As the world's largest human gathering approached, IRCS was prepared to provide aid, comfort, and care to millions of pilgrims and participants.





Glimpses of IRCS response at Kumbh 2019



Successful execution & completion of Red Cross/ St. John Ambulance Camp in Kumbh Mela Prayagraj 2019 where thousands of Monks, Saints & pilgrims benefitted from the Red Cross/St John Camp. Following services were provided to the visitors in the mela 2019; First Aid, Ambulance Service, Awareness & Promotion of Red Cross, Health Camps and Assistance like guidance and information, emergency help, offering amenities such as seating, water stations, or assistance with carrying items, especially for elderly or disabled, at the Ghats & Mela area.



IRCS AT MAHAKUMBH PRAYAGRAJ 2025

During the Mahakumbh in Prayagraj in 2025, more than 660 million devotees and tourists converged for a spiritual experience. The Indian Red Cross Society (IRCS) played a crucial role in ensuring the safety and well-being of all participants. Here's a snapshot of the IRCS's contributions and initiatives that were implemented:



Medical Services: IRCS provided medical aid to pilgrims and participants through a network of health camps, hospitals, and first-aid centers. A fleet of ambulances & emergency response teams, were on standby 24x7 during the Mahakumbh.



Disaster Management: IRCS had a comprehensive disaster management plan to respond to any emergency situations during the Mahakumbh Mela. The IRCS emergency services includes search and rescue, evacuation and relief distribution.



Food and Nutrition: The IRCS provided nutritious food and meals to pilgrims, particularly the elderly, children, and those with disabilities.



Assistance to the visitors at the Ghats & Mela area: IRCS provided nutritious food and meals to pilgrims, particularly the elderly, children, and those with disabilities.



Awareness and Promotion of Red Cross: The IRCS organized social activities and educational programs to promote the humanitarian values of the Red Cross Movement among pilgrims.



Water and Sanitation: IRCS contributed to ensure access to clean drinking water and proper sanitation facilities for pilgrims. This included setting up water purification plants, sanitation stations, and providing hygiene kits.

A HEARTFELT JOURNEY OF SERVICE AT KUMBH MELA 2025

"Service is the highest duty"—with this guiding principle, I began my journey in disaster preparedness as a Supervisor with the Indian Red Cross Society in Uttar Pradesh in 2014. Currently, I serve as Secretary in Lakhimpur Kheri; however, I have always considered myself a volunteer dedicated to service above all.

The Kumbh Mela in Prayagraj 2025 was made exceptional by a rare alignment of celestial bodies after 144 years. In this auspicious event, I was honored to be appointed as Co-Mela In-Charge and Accountant by Dr. Himabindu Naik, General Secretary of Red Cross Uttar Pradesh, along with Mr. Akhilendra Shahi, Vice-Chairman, and Mr. Arun Singh, Treasurer. I was profoundly grateful for the opportunity to serve the millions of devotees who flocked to this sacred gathering.

Since the commencement of the Kumbh Mela, the Red Cross provided essential first aid services to thousands of pilgrims, offering emotional support to the injured, guiding travelers through the confluence areas, reuniting lost families, providing meal arrangements, and conducting cleanliness awareness campaigns.

Among the many rewarding experiences at the Kumbh, the most poignant for me was saving the lives of two women through divine grace. While working in the office, there was a sudden power outage. When I stepped outside, I saw towering black smoke rising from Sector 19. Our team quickly arrived on the scene. There, we witnessed terrified people running for their lives amidst fierce flames. My attention was drawn to a narrow alley between some tents, where a few individuals emerged, panic-stricken. As I attempted to enter that alley, I heard the terrifying sound of a cylinder exploding. Momentarily overwhelmed, I hesitated but then heard a woman's desperate cries from within a tent.

Rushing back, I found a woman who was traumatized, her face severely burnt. I grabbed her hand and urged, "We need to get out quickly!" She instinctively pulled away, lamenting that all her belongings were burnt and expressing her despair. With no time to reason with her, I forcefully pulled her behind me, successfully getting both of us outside just as several cylinders exploded in succession. The crowd around us erupted in applause, and I teared up recalling that moment.

At Kumbh, I encountered numerous incidents that filled me with pride. Yet, there were moments where my inability to help left me with regrets. The Red Cross ingrained in me the importance of selflessness and the essence of saving lives. I was deeply grateful for the opportunity to serve sadhus, the injured, and helpless travelers on the sacred land of Prayag through the Red Cross.

I am Jayprakash Shukla, the Secretary of the Indian Red Cross Society, Sultanpur District, Uttar Pradesh. I had the honor of serving as the Kumbh Mela In-Charge since 2019, while also overseeing the Magh Mela.

My efforts in facilitating the successful execution of the Kumbh Mela in 2019 were recognized by the Honorable Governor of Uttar Pradesh, who conferred upon me a token of appreciation. Additionally, I had the privilege of being honored twice by the Governor for my contributions alongside my team during the Jagannath Puri Rath Yatra in Odisha. Furthermore, I received a Gold Medal for my exemplary services provided for 43 days under the St. John Ambulance Brigade during the Commonwealth Games.

Since 2019, I had consistently provided my services as the In-Charge for the Mahakumbh and Magh Mela in Prayagraj, Uttar Pradesh. During this time, I extended my services to approximately 45,000 devotees, assisting them in various capacities, such as lost-and-found assistance, CPR, and emergency response during fire incidents.

As we approached the Mahakumbh Mela 2025, I had already begun preparations. From December 23, 2024, I provided my services at Sector 5, Tulsi Marg, Harishchandra Chauraha, and Sector 24, Chakr Madhav Marg, alongside my able colleagues, Dipika Singh and Jasper Shukla.

In collaboration with the Fire Department, I played a crucial role in responding to fire incidents in sectors 19, 22, and 16. Noteworthy was my successful resuscitation of Sita Devi, aged approximately 65 years, who was promptly transported to the hospital via CPR. Additionally, I was able to save Rajesh Singh, a 4-year-old from District Jawahar, Rajasthan, ensuring his safety before reuniting him with his family. In another instance, Naresh Chandra, a 33-year-old from Sasaram, Bihar, received critical first aid and was subsequently taken to the Sector 25 camp hospital.

Throughout that journey, I remained steadfast in providing primary care to over 35,000 devotees, ensuring their safety and well-being.
